JVP undergrads threatened me with death – Prof Nalin

Science Faculty Dean of the Kelaniya University Prof. Nalin de Silva told *The Island* that pro - JVP students in the university had threatened him with death. He had lodged a complaint at the Kiribathgoda police station.

The Kelaniya University was closed indefinitely on Wednesday (25) due a students clash between the Arts Faculty and Science Faculty students.

"Students Council is being handled by the pro - JVP Inter University Students Federation (IUSF). They don't have power in Science Faculty. They wanted Science Faculty students to agree with their political views and if they did not it would be bad for the university. As the Dean of the Science Faculty I'm also with my faculty students and that is why they

threaten me," Prof. Silva said.

He said that the Science Faculty students did not want to sabotage the 'Bihi Dora Abiyasa' arts festival. It was not a problem created with over the arts festival. The problem had been there for over a decade.

Convener of the IUSF Udul Premaratne denied Prof. de Silva's claims. He said that there was no political agenda behind the problem.

"The university closed on the second day of our annual arts festival. We paid advances for everythings and now our money has been wasted. We are the most affected faction by the university closure. That is why I say

we don't want to create troubles," Premaratne said.

Vice Chancellor of the University Prof. Sarath Amunugama said that he was aware of the threat to Prof. Nalin de Silva.

OIC of the Kiribathgoda Police Chief Inspector Chaminda Edirisuriya said

they commenced the investigations according to the complaint made by Prof. Nalin de Silva.

Clogged city canals cause of dengue

The Colombo Municipal Council identified the clogging of canals with garbage as one of the main reasons for its inability to control dengue in the city. People dispose their garbage in large drains and canals thus blocking the flow of water, Chief of the Public Health Department of the Municipality Dr. Pradeep Kariyawasam said. He said yesterday (26) that

the number of dengue patients reported in the city so far this month stood at 64. In January there were 105 patients. He said that there had been one death reported within the two months. Last year there were only 67 cases reported during the first two months of the year.

A majority of the reported cases were from Mutwal, Mattakkuliya, Dr. Kariyawasam said. The other affected areas

were the Aluth Kade canal area, Grandpass, Maradana, Borella, Narahenpita and Kirulapone.

The Public Health Department Chief said that the Council was issuing notices to those in charge of the canals to clear them of the garbage. However, the CMC needs evidence to take action against those who dispose garbage into canals. "Even a photograph would do," he said.

More doctors go North

The Government Medical Officers' Association said there were 227 doctors serving in welfare camps and hospitals in the North, East and North-Eastern provinces. They had completed their internship this year and volunteered to serve in Trincomalee, Polonnaruwa, Vavuniya and Mannar.

Spokesman for the GMOA Dr. Upul Gunasekara said ten more doctors would leave from the South for Vavuniya today (27). The doctors are being deployed to the North on a roster basis, he said.

"We are providing our fullest support to assist internally displaced persons arriving in Vavuniya," he said. The Coordinating Centre set up by the GMOA last week has been synchronizing its services with assistance from the Health Ministry, the World Health Organization and the Ministry of Defense (MOD). The MOD is providing the necessary clearance and security for doctors

going up North while the Health Ministry has mainly been assisting with food and lodging. The WHO has assisted in providing transport for doctors and other medical staff.

Dr. Gunasekara said they had received over two million rupees worth of drugs and medical equipment from private pharmaceutical companies which would be handed over to the welfare camps and the hospital in Vavuniya and Mannar next week.

"These are also our people, and right now they need our support more than anything," he said.

A large quantity of drugs is needed for patients suffering from respiratory and cardiac diseases. And the GMOA Coordinating Centre has had a tremendous feed back from private drug companies who have come forward to provide the required drugs, he said.
