Entitled "Des Kelly's Baila Party," the CD has eight highly-charged bailas, done in the Des Kelly style, and is mixed with a couple of 'bonus' English vocal tracks, with Esric Jackson of Replay 6 fame, his wife, and a few local musicians from the Melbourne scene.

From days gone by, the crooner has stunned his fans

The name Orville Burrell might not mean a great deal to most folks. However, as Jamaican-born, New York-based reggae artist Shaggy, he's become something of a global phenomenon, shifting well over 20 million records worldwide.

Having joined the United States Marine Corps at the age of 19, it was only after leaving three years later that he decided to pursue a career in music.

Debut single 'Oh Carolina', a cover of The Folkes Brothers dancehall reggae standard, may have struggled to reach the Top 50 in the

'Shaggy & Friends' is shrouded in controversy, consisting entirely of collaborations without obtaining permission from Shaggy himself.

Meanwhile last year's "official" release, 'Summer In Kingston', finds itself nominated for a Grammy Award in February 2012 - Shaggy's fifth nomination for such a prestigious accolade.

Later, Shaggy will be headlining a charity event for the Bustamante Children's Hospital in Kingston alongside Ne-Yo, Lauryn Hill and Eve.

In the meantime, he's also laying down

States, but in the UK it stayed at the number one spot for two weeks providing a launchpad for a career that has spanned nearly two decades.

Since then, he's topped the charts in several countries around the world with the likes of 'Boombastic', 'It Wasn't Me', 'Angel' and 'Feel The Rush', while harnessing a reputation as a successful producer of some merit as well as recording artist.

Last year alone (2011) has seen two albums bearing the name Shaggy; the first of which,

demosters his next long player as well as producing an album with Sly & Robbie.

Shaggy performed in Colombo (thanks to E FM), at the Sugathadasa Indoor Stadium, to a full house. And his fans present that evening gave him a standing ovation.

It still remains the best concert Sri Lankan music lovers have ever seen in Colombo.

Shaggy performed ABSOLUTELY LIVE, with his own backing band, and he was on stage for more than 90 minutes, and extended

the show by returning quite a few times to oblige his screaming fans.

The foreign artistes we now experience in Colombo is crap; they don't have the repertoire to handle a 90-minute concert.

It's an effort for them to even do a one hour show because songs are repeated. And they perform to tracks.

Many believe that even their voices are pre-recorded. Could be - nothing is impossible!
